#### November 20, 2019 - Yoshon.com Status Update

Work has been continuous on updating Yoshon.com this season. So far, all of the updates from the *Preliminary Guide to Chodosh*, and over half of the Canadian updates have been completed. The remainder of Canada and the recent updates from South Africa are still in the process. When the *Final Guide to Chodosh* comes out, all dates and information will be updated reflecting the date when it is released. Most likely, these will be the final dates for the rest of the season in the USA.

Other behind-the-scenes work on the site has been ongoing, such as streamlining product list entries for better search results, obtaining new shelf life information on additional Kellogg's products, and correcting and/or adding more UPC information in preparation for the scanning function in the upcoming Yoshon.com app. This UPC information can even be used to search on Yoshon.com right now for even more accuracy in finding products and their status.

The wheat status of Post cereals this year is being investigated. Since the *Guide* merely lists all "Wheat Flour" as being *yoshon*, we are inquiring to Project Chodosh to see if this includes *all* wheat, (such as for puffed wheat and shredded wheat). This may allow for more cereals have an actual "yoshon" status, and in that case, we would update the "Yoshon Cereals List for 5780" accordingly. Note that each time the *Yoshon Cereals List* is updated, the direct download link changes, so if one wants a constant, never-changing link to get to the most current *Yoshon Cereals List*, please bookmark this link from the "Updates and Downloads" page: <https://yoshon.com/updates-downloads/#YoshonCerealsList>

#### November 20, 2019 - Mondelēz Global LLC Announces Voluntary Recall on Cheese Nips

Mondelēz Global LLC announced a voluntary recall of a limited quantity of Cheese Nips (11 oz. Box) product in the United States due to the potential presence of small food-grade yellow plastic pieces from a dough scraper that was incorporated into the production process of a small amount of product. The company became aware of this issue when yellow plastic pieces were noticed on the manufacturing equipment.

This recall is limited exclusively to the Cheese Nips product listed in the grid, available at retail stores nationwide. No other Mondelēz Global LLC products nor any other geographies are included in or affected by this recall.

*Note from TYNI:* Since Nabisco/Mondelēz Global LLC has been notoriously difficult to work with concerning obtaining information, their products are not listed on Yoshon.com. However, the shelf life according to some distributors puts the Cheese Nips' "Best By" cutoff dates at somewhere around March 12, 2020, making the recalled batches most likely *chodosh*. We decided to publish the recall anyway, since there is no verifiable date code information to go by.
