### New Yoshon Updates

#### November 24, 2019 – The New Yoshon.com “Yoshon Cereals List” is Released

This update is perhaps the most complete yet, featuring several store brands from the USA, and additional cereals from around the world. Newer entries are Nestle/General Mills from Poland, all the current updates from Canada and South Africa.

It must be noted that this list is *not* final for the year by any means. As cereals become *chodosh*, the list will be updated periodically. Those that have the parenthetical “(This may change)”, most likely will disappear eventually. There are however, many “always-Yoshon” cereals to choose from due to the manufacturers using Winter Wheat (see below). Since this list is ever-changing, the *link* to the list changes every single time it has been updated.

Most likely, these dates from the *Final Guide* will be the last and current dates for the rest of the season in the USA.
