August 24, 2020 – General Chodosh Cutoff Dates Sheet Updated

We got clarification from Project Chodosh last night on the status of freshly baked goods. Most are still *yoshon*, but the *chodosh* flour is just starting to make its way to the stores and bakeries. This is good news for those who may have stocked up a little bit late, that all wheat products purchased between August 6th and 19th should all still be *yoshon*. We updated the “General Chodosh Cutoff Dates Sheet” today to reflect this, and the status on Post and General Mills oat cereals. As always, we will keep you updated any time we hear any news, as there still were no dates for pasta.

June 16, 2020 – News on Sallie Mishaan's Kaak

We apologize for the delay, but this was missed in past alerts. We have recently had trouble getting direct information from the OK. We first inquired to them about this product which had been listed in the *Guide to Chodosh* last season as being *yoshon*. The OK had a *Pas Yisroel* alert on this product back in March, and we immediately contacted them to see if it affected the *yoshon* status as well. We did not receive a response, and this alert was discovered a bit later. Since the product is no longer kosher, therefore it would no longer be a *yoshon* concern anyway.

The OK’s alert was as follows:

“24 Sivan 5780 – June 16, 2020 –Sallie Mishaan’s Kaak is No Longer Certified by OK Kosher Certification

Please be advised that due to kashrus violations, Sallie Mishaan’s Gourmet Kaak (1845 Coney Island Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11230) is no longer certified by OK Kosher Certification.”

[Note from TYNI: Upon investigation, Sallie Mishaan’s Gourmet Kaak still has their products listed as being “Under Supervision of the OK” on their website “Kosher Valet” where people can place orders for it. (Let the Buyer Beware!) We will post the current status of their products on Yoshon.com as “Status: No Longer Kosher”.]
