Brand: Sysco Product: All Purpose H&R Flour Company: Sysco Corp., Houston TX
Issue: Unauthorized OU P

The Orthodox Union certifies Sysco All Purpose H&R Flour as an OU product but not as an OU P Kosher for Passover product. Some 50 lb. bags bear an unauthorized OU P mark. Corrective actions are being implemented.
