The New Chodosh Season is Here!

Most of the dates are in, with only a tentative date for pastas, and the big cereal companies, General Mills, Post and Quaker. If you haven't started to stock up yet, you may be too late. *Chodosh* Oats have already been spotted in stores like Walmart and ShopRite. Fresh-baked goods may also be too late, so check those dates, and try to find stores that have frozen stock that they thaw and then put on the shelves, like Trader Joe's and Aldi. Refrigerated items with short shelf-life times, so those should also be a priority. See the updates below for more details.



Revised General Cutoff Date Sheet

We just revised our General Cutoff Date Sheet to make it even more convenient! Dates are listed as they most often appear on products, and dates listed as numbers are in parenthesis next to them. The respective base Julian date codes for the actual cutoff date have been added at the end to help determine products' status as one is shopping for brands that are not listed on our site. We hope you find these additions even more helpful.



A Reminder on Yoshon.com Official App Downloads

August 23, 2022 – The Dates Are In!

“Dear Chodosh Subscribers,

The harvest is continuing at a very quick pace.

The final oats cut off date is **August 13th** with a purchase date of **August 21**. Please pre-purchase oats now. This cut off date does not apply to General Mills or Post cereals that will have a cut off date sometime in September. (please note that we have confirmed that chodosh oats are now on the shelves in walmart and shoprite and frum distributors have received chodosh oats).

The wheat harvest is proceeding quickly. The final cut off date for spring wheat is **August 18th** with a purchase date of **August 28th** for packaged goods and **August 22** for fresh baked goods.

Barley has a final cut off date of **August 10th** with a purchase date of **August 25**. This date is earlier than the estimate.

Durum wheat used in Pasta products has an estimated cut off date of **August 27** and a purchase date of **September 4th**.

Clarification: *Chodosh* date is the first possible date for the manufacturer to have used Chodosh grain in production. Purchase date is the last safe date to purchase grain products in stores without checking for Yoshon status or codes.

I am sorry that I was unable to send out an update last week due to the birth of Yosef Roskamm.
