Updates on Some Items and Projected Cutoff Dates

August 1-10, 2022 – Always Yoshon Items Reported from Rabbi Wagshal of New Square

“Unger's frozen Pie shells (all sizes) are always Yoshon.

The following items are always Yoshon:

Unger's Kishke Mix.

Unger's Matzo Ball Mix, All Varieties.

Unger's Batter Mix.

Unger's Crunch and Bake, Coating Mixes – All Varieties.

Unger's Corn Flake Crumbs.

Unger's Bread Crumbs.

Snack Delite Cake Mixes – All Flavors

August 9, 2022 – Cheerios Projected Cutoff Date Period

The projected cutoff date for Cheerios is sometime in early October.

So far, all dates are *tentative* only and subject to change. General Mill's dates for Cheerios and other cereals are always later than other companies. Below is a general estimate of the cutoff dates for various items compiled from various *kashrut* agency reports:

Oats: August 3, 2022.

Wheat: August 12, 2022.

Barley: August 15, 2022.

Rye: Always Yoshon from the US and Canada ONLY.

Spelt: Always Yoshon from the US and Canada ONLY.

General Mills Cheerios (should include all Oat cereals): October 1, 2022 (Reported only as “Early October”).

Beer: November 15, 2022.

Barley Malt: December 15, 2022.

Soy Sauce (containing Wheat): January 12, 2023.

Matza and **Matza Meal** products: Always Yoshon.

As soon as we have finalized dates, we will post our General Cutoff Dates List and start updating Yoshon.com.
